

Camouflage Children's Crochet Poncho

Skill Level: Beginner

Kids Sizes: S (M-L)

(S) = 4 to 6, (M) = 8 to 10, (L) = 12 to 14

Materials:

~Crochet Hook K/101/2-6.50mm

~Red Heart Yarn (6 oz. per skein)

Worsted~ Medium: Camouflage

1 skein for small & 2 skeins for Medium and Large.

~Yarn needle

Gauge: 12 Stitches + 8 Rnds = 4"

Pattern Notes:

Weave in loose ends as you work

Rnd 1: Loosely ch 54 (60-66), 1 dc in 4th ch from hook, 1 dc in same space as last dc, * skip 1 ch, 1 dc in next ch, 1 dc in same space as last dc, repeat from * to last ch, 1 dc in last ch, turn.

Rnd 2: ch 3, skip 1 dc, * 2 dc between next two dc, skip 1 dc, repeat from *, ending skip last dc, 1 dc in 3rd of 3 ch, turn.

Repeat Rnd 2: until you reach the number of Rnds indicated for the size poncho you are making.

(S) = 19, (M) = 21, (L) = 23

Make 2. Join both halves to form Poncho.

Neck Line & Border Edging:

Neck Line:

Rnd 1: sl in any stitch, ch 1, sc evenly around neckline, sl st in first sc. (Fasten Off).

Border Edging:

Rnd 1: sl in any stitch, ch 1, sc evenly around neckline, sl st in first sc. (Fasten Off).

Optional Thick Border. Poncho With Out Fringe.

Rnd 2: ch 1, *dc in first sc *, repeat from * around, sl st in first dc.

Rnd 3-6: Repeat Rnd 2. (Fasten Off).

Fringe: Work fringe in every other Sc around border. Cut 2 lengths of yarn 12 inches long, fold stands in half, insert hook in stitch, draw fold through stitch on hook to form a loop, draw cut ends through loop on hook, pull gently to secure. Trim ends evenly.
