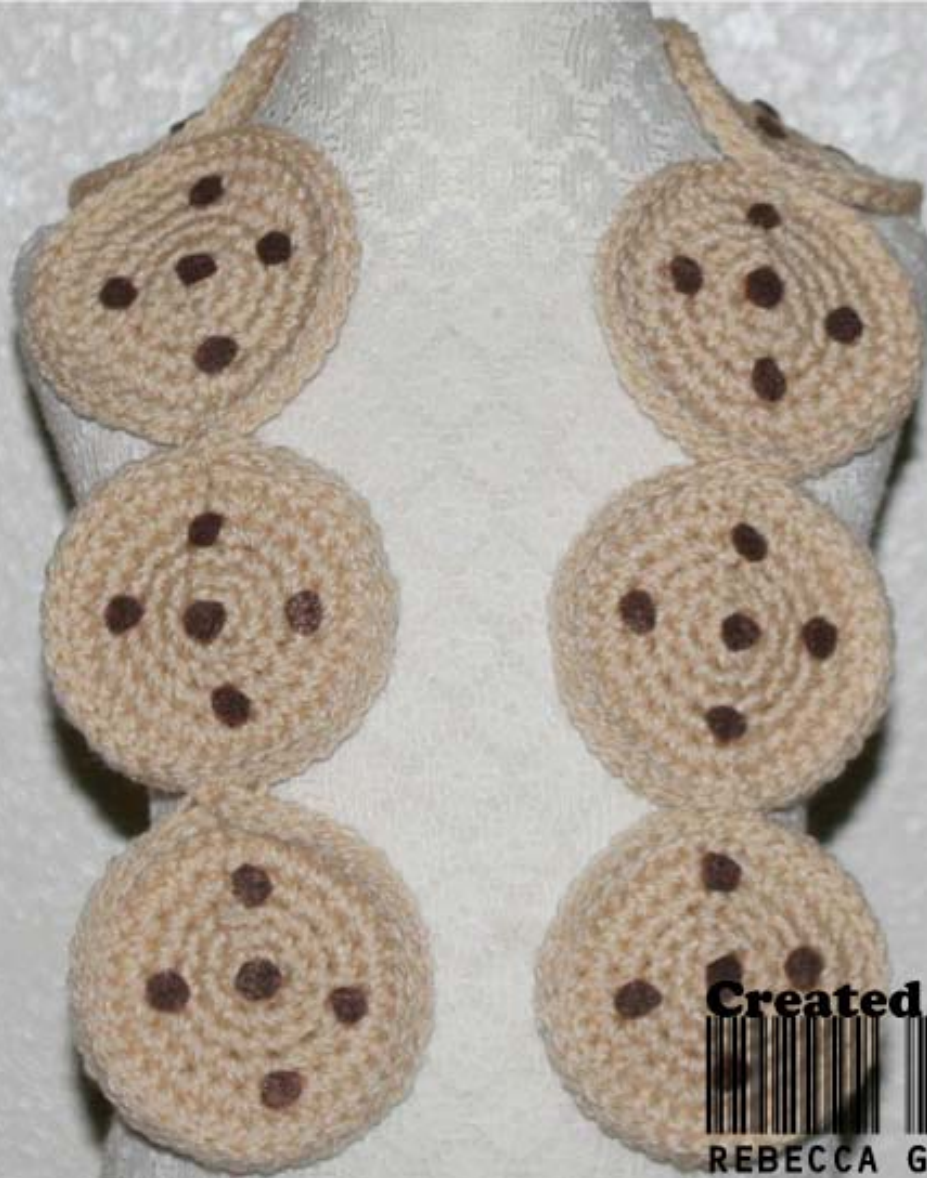


# Chocolate Chip Cookie

# Chocolate Chip Cookie

## Finished Size:

Cookie Measures

3.5" across by 4.5" high

**Skill level:** beginner, easy

## Materials:

♥ Used For the Cookie:

Worsted Weight, 100% Acrylic, 150 yards "dark cream or off white"

♥ Yarn Needle

♥ H / 8-5.00 hook or hook size needed to obtain gauge

## Gauge:

4 sc = 1 inch; 4 rows = 1 inch

## Basic Stitches:

ch, sl st, sc, hdc, dc, inc = increase, sp = space

## Cookie

Rnd 1: Ch 3, sl st to form ring, ch 1, 6 sc in ring, sl st to first sc.

Rnd 2: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around, sl st to first sc.

Rnd 3: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, sl st to first sc.

Rnd 4: Ch 1, 2 sc in each sc around, sl st to first sc.

Rnd 5: Ch 1, \* (sc, 2 sc) in next sp, \* repeat from \* to \* around, sl st to first sc.

Rnd 6: Ch 1, sc in each sc around, sl st to first sc.

Rnd 7: Ch 1, sl st in each sc around, fasten off.

Note: Make sure to leave a decent amount of yarn length when fastening off so that you can hand sew each of the cookie section together as you create the scarf.



## Chocolate Chips

Using a whole punch or doing it the old fashioned way as I did cut out as many chocolate chips as you would like to decorate the top of your cookies with using brown felt from your craft section of the store. Using a washable liquid fabric glue to attach each felt piece to the cookie however you would like.
