Smores 3D Scarf

Finished Size:

Each Smore Measures

3" across by 3" high

Skill level: beginner, easy

Materials:

♥ Used For Gram Cracker:

Worsted Medium Weight, 80% Acrylic & 20% Nylon, 326 yards

♥ Used For Chocolate:

Worsted Medium Weight, 80% Acrylic & 20% Nylon, 326 yards

♥ Used For Marshmallow:

Worsted Medium Weight, 80% Acrylic & 20% Nylon, 326 yards

♥ Yarn Needle

♥ G / 6-4.25 hook or hook size needed to obtain gauge

Gauge:

4 sc = 1 inch; 4 rows = 1 inch

Basic Stitches:

ch, sl st, sc, hdc

Notes:

Color A = Tan (Work 2 Smore Motifs)

Color B = White (Work 1 Smore Motif)

Color C = Brown (Work 1 Smore Motif)



Smore Motif

Row 1: ch 12, hdc in 3rd ch from hook, hdc in each ch across, turn.

Row 2: ch 2, hdc in next st, hdc across, ending with hdc in tch, turn.

Row 3 through 8: Repeat Row 2, fasten off.

Note: Once you have all 4 layers to create your 3D Smore be sure to layer the Smore Motifs on top of each other with Color A on bottom, Color B, Color C, and then Color A on top.

Next you will hand sew all the layers together. Repeat this until you have 10 completed Smores. If you are making this for a child you can use less Smores to make the scarf.

Connecting The Smores

Using Color A join on bottom edge of Smore by sl st in the 3rd st in.

Row 1: ch 1, sc in same sp, sc in next 5 st, turn.

Row 2: ch 1, sc across, turn.

Row 3 through 10: repeat row 2, fasten off and leave long piece of yarn.

(Note: Be sure to leave one Smore with out a connector. Count in to the 3rd st and hand sew each gram cracker connector to the next Smore until finished)
