

Tiger Eye Half Shoulder Crochet Poncho

Skill Level: Beginner

Size: (S, M, L, XL)

Gauge: (1 dc = 1"), (dc, sc, dc = 1")

Materials:

~Crochet Hook K/101/2-6 50mm

~ Jewel Box Chenille (2.5 oz. per skein): 3 skein's TIGER EYE

~Worsted Weight ~ Medium

~Yarn needle

Pattern Notes:

Weave in loose ends as you work



1st Rnd: ch 44, sc in 3rd ch from hook, sc in each ch across, turn.

2nd Rnd: ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch1 sp), skip next sc, dc in next sc, * ch1, skip next sc, dc in next sc * rep across, turn.

3rd Rnd: ch 4 (counts as first dc and ch1 sp), dc in next dc, * ch 1, dc in next dc* rep across, ch 1, dc in ch1 space, turn.

4th Rnd: ch 1, sc in first dc, * sc in next ch 1 space, sc in next dc * rep across, sc in ch1 space, turn.

Repeat 2nd, 3rd, & 4th Rnds Until you have the amount of Rnds needed for the following sizes.

Small = 45 Rnds, Med = 49 Rnds, Large = 52 Rnds, X-Large = 55 Rnds

Last Rnd: ch 1, sl stitch in each sc across, Fasten off.

Make 1 Panel.

1. Fold Panel in half. The solid green line represents the poncho folded in half.
2. Hand sew the top two corners of the panel together where you see the dotted green line.
